At TRT Communications Ltd., we take data protection and privacy seriously. This GDPR compliance statement outlines our commitment to compliance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) as it applies to the United Kingdom.

TRT Communications (hereinafter referred to as "we," "us," or "our") is the data controller responsible for the processing of personal data on our website. We have a Data Protection Officer (DPO) who can be reached at jerry@trtcommunications.co.uk. The DPO oversees our data protection activities and ensures compliance with GDPR requirements.

We collect and process personal data for specific, legitimate, and transparent purposes. The personal data collected may include names, email addresses, contact information, and other information necessary for the purposes stated. We use this information primarily for:

1. Providing requested information or services.
2. Managing and responding to inquiries.
3. Complying with legal obligations.
4. Improving user experience on our website.

Our data processing activities are carried out based on one or more of the following legal bases as required under GDPR:

1. Consent: When required, we obtain explicit consent before processing personal data.
2. Contractual Necessity: Processing is necessary for the performance of a contract or pre-contractual measures.
3. Legal Obligation: Processing is necessary to comply with a legal obligation.
4. Legitimate Interests: Processing is necessary for our legitimate interests, provided they are not overridden by the interests or fundamental rights and freedoms of data subjects.

We retain personal data only for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which it was collected or as required by applicable laws and regulations.

Under GDPR, data subjects have various rights, including the right to access, rectify, erase, restrict processing, data portability, and object to the processing of their personal data. We implement appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect personal data from unauthorised access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction. Our security measures are regularly reviewed and updated.

If you believe that we have not complied with GDPR or have concerns about our data processing activities, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) in the UK or another relevant supervisory authority.
